The group becomes unmanageable	Party	Leader to terminate that groups activity and return to the Church or return the disruptive scout back to the Church in one of the collecting cars - ensuring that required ratios are maintained	
Danger from House holder	Party	Scouts should not enter the property. If requested to do so to pick up Jumble they should call an adult Leader to be extra vigilant whist young person is at the doorway to the house	
Injury from weight of load	Party	Scouts to be instructed how to lift a box If the load is to heavy the scout is to call for an adult or split the load into smaller sections
